

Scrubber Brushes and Brooms

Ever since automated models were invented during the middle of the 20th century, there are many floor scrubber kinds available. The automated kinds are quite analogous to a push lawn mower. There were a set of rotary brushes which worked the cleansers into the floor to be able to scrub the floors clean by lifting the dirt away.

The modern floor scrubber was more effective than doing floors manually since it leaves less water behind and eliminates the need to get down on knees and hands to wash the floor.
